

FEI WORLD DRIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2017 for COMBINED PONIES

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

CH-M-A Combined Ponies – Minden (GER)

Dates – 15-20 August 2017

1. Qualification period

Start: 1 January 2016

End: TBC – at the date of the Nominated entries

2. Qualification criteria

To be applied in conjunction with Art. 913 and 914.1-6 of the FEI Driving Rules.

Drivers:

Open to athletes who meet the following criteria:

At two (2) International combined driving events, 3* Drivers must achieve a score of 65 points or less in the Dressage test¹ and have successfully completed (without Elimination, Disqualification or Retirement) all three competitions (Dressage, Cones, Marathon) in their own class.

One of the qualifying result as defined above must be achieved no earlier than on the 1st January of the year in which the Championships take place and no later than the end date of the qualification period.

¹ Pony Four-in-Hand: dressage tests 3*D P4 or 3*B HP4

¹ Pony Pairs: dressage test 3*C HP2 or 3*B HP2

¹ Pony Singles: dressage tests 3*C HP1 or 3*B HP1

Maximum Driven penalty points allowed at the Championships in Dressage as per Art 914.4: 75 points

The following Dressage tests will be run at the Championships:

Pony Four in Hand: Dressage test 3*B HP4

Pony Pairs: Dressage test 3*B HP2

Pony Singles: Dressage test 3*B HP1
