Classes

Category	Age	Horse/Pony
Children	12-14 y.o.	Single Pony
Junior	14-18 y.o.	Single Pony/ Pony Pairs
Young Drivers	16-21 y.o.	Single Pony/ Single Horse/ Pony Pairs

Horse-Pony classes shall be run as following :

- Dressage , Marathon, Cones, Combined for children
- Dressage, Marathon, Cones, Combined for Single Ponies
(Athletes 14 – 21 years)
- Dressage, Marathon, Cones, Combined for Pair Ponies
(Athletes 14 – 21 years)
- Dressage, Marathon, Cones, Combined for Single Horses
(Athletes 16 – 21 years)

Entries: As per schedule.

Teams: A national team shall consist of at least one Child, one Junior and one Young Driver and each Nation is entitled to send up to a maximum of six Athletes. NFs which cannot send a team may send up to six Athletes in total as individual entries.

The team classification will be determined by adding together the final combined scores of the best team for one child, one Junior and one Young Driver. Only those scores of the team Members who have completed all three Competitions without Elimination can be counted towards the final team scores.

Individuals: All entered athletes will compete as Individuals in their respective classes.

 Individual Junior : 1 Gold, 1 Silver and 1 Bronze
 Individual Children: 1 Gold, 1 Silver and 1 Bronze

Team

Youth team: 6 Gold, 6 Silver and 6 Bronze
 (up to 6 Medals for NFs who will have entered the maximum of six Athletes consisting of up to two Children, two Juniors and two Young Drivers).
